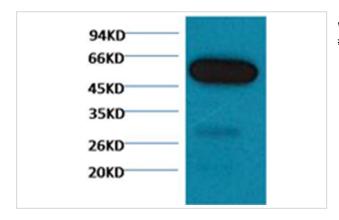

Background

The most common members of the tubulin family are α -tubulin and β -tubulin, the proteins that make up microtubules. Each has a molecular weight of approximately 55 KD. Microtubules are assembled from dimers of α - and β -tubulin.
